ON THE DAY

- Meet your tour guides in the Roundhouse Visitor Centre, where you'll be set up with our audio system.
- Its quite noisy in the city, so we use a tour guide audio system to ensure everyone can hear. Please do bring along your own headphones if you have them. You'll need headphones with standard "mini-jack" connection, as pictured. (We will have enough disposable earphones for the group, but for we'd like to limit the amount of disposables that we use when we can)

- Make sure to keep an eye on the weather forecast as the tour is
- mostly outside; so prepare for the sun or the rain.

THE ROUTE

The route covers a range of Birmingham history, personal stories and landmarks between the Roundhouse, Centenary Square and Brindley Place.



Starting at the Roundhouse, your group will be taken along the beautiful Birmingham canals, finding lots of 'B's' along the way.



The walking tour includes:


- Birmingham Canals
- Brindley Place
- Centenary Square
- Chamberlain Square
- Broad Street



The tour finishes in Brindley Place, but you're welcome to join us for a gentle stroll back to the Roundhouse for 20% off in the cafe, Jonathans in the Roundhouse

ACCESSIBILITY

When you arrive at the Roundhouse, the cobbled courtyard is quite steep and a little uneven in places. Please make sure to wear sensible footwear.



The route is designed with access in mind, avoiding stairs where possible. At one part of the tour, there are steps, but there is a lift to use. There are one or two slightly steep inclines around the Brindley Place.



Hearing induction loop. Our tour guide system has an induction loop option which is compatible with analogue and digital hearing aids when set to "T". Let us know if there are members of the group that would like to use these.
