ON THE DAY

- Make sure to keep an eye on the weather forecast as the tour is outside; so prepare for the sun or the rain.
- Its quite noisy in the city, so we use a tour guide audio system to ensure everyone can hear. We will have enough disposable earphones for the group, but for we'd like to limit the amount of disposables that we use. Please do bring along your own headphones if you have them. You'll need headphones with standard "mini-jack" connection, as pictured.

ACCESSIBILITY

Some information around accessibility for your walking tour:

Hearing induction loop. Our tour guide system has an induction loop option which is compatible with analogue and digital hearing aids when set to "T". Let us know if there are members of the group that would like to use these.



The route has been designed to be free of steps and to minimise slopes. The only steps are in the ICC but there is a lift between levels.



When you arrive at the Roundhouse, the cobbled courtyard is quite steep and a little uneven in places. Please make sure to wear sensible footwear.
